Enterprise Equipment Check-Out Program:

Audio Video Captioning Services: Multimedia Services offers audio and video captioning services via UCO on Demand (Kaltura) using automated free machine AI captioning tools averaging 85% accuracy. Professional human captioning available with 99% accuracy upon request (fees may apply).

Audio Video Recording Services: Multimedia Services offer conference and event recording services. A Two-week lead time is required for any request and media is made available via a streaming archive link.

Live Streaming Media Services: Allows an event to be streamed live or on demand for all UCO sponsored conferences and events and special presentations. A two-week lead time is required.

Application Administration for Multimedia Systems:

Kaltura (UCO On Demand): <u>UCO On Demand</u> is a media management and content delivery system, hosted by Kaltura, for higher education that provides a means for managing, delivering, creating, and accessing university-related media content. The solution is designed for academic purposes.

Enterprise Web Conferencing Services: UCO <u>Zoom</u> is the web, audio and video conferencing system at UCO. It offers the ability to create online virtual meetings via the web using audio and video conferencing hosted service all supported via mobile devices, desktops, and room systems.

Enterprise Digital Signage: Across the university, many buildings offer digital signage options to promote university-related information, events, programs and initiatives, for faculty, staff and students utilizing **Samsung's Magic Info** application.

Q-SYS Reflect Enterprise Manager: Application monitoring and support of AV devices across classrooms, conference rooms and meeting spaces.

CVENT: The University of Central Oklahoma has adopted **CVENT** as the official cloud-based solution for large in person and virtual (Hybrid) conferences and events.
